Spacing: APA only requires one space at the end of a sentence.
Punctuation: APA requires the following for punctuation use.
Comma: APA requires the serial, or Oxford, comma when writing series. For example: Cities in Spain include Madrid, Barcelona, and Valencia.
Period: APA requires periods when abbreviating names (e.g. J. W. Smith) but not ...
